Information from JBA's nationwide Australia Flood Map is analysed at each property to see how flood frequency and severity can change for a profile of possible flood intensities simulated over thousands of years. This is combined with flood defence data and vulnerability functions to derive a risk-reflective, technical price for flood.

Risk is expressed as an annual damage ratio (ADR®) whereby JBA's Australia Pricing Data represents the expected annual cost of flood damage at a single location as a proportion of the sum insured.
